Basics of woodworking, photography, and graphics are presented in a safe environment to prepare the student to make informed option choices in the high school years.

In the time frame allowed, the student will spend half their time in the wood shop area with the other half being split between photography and graphics.

In Woods, the student will: learn the use of hand and power tools to complete simple projects.

In Photography, the student will: learn the basics of photo from picture taking to darkroom developing.

In Graphics, the student will: learn the basics of screen printing.
